RETURNS MILLIONS TO NASHVILLE
ECONOMY

Over \$7 million in federal refunds were claimed by area families and returned to the Nashville economy at tax time, thanks to the efforts of the Nashville Wealth Building Alliance (NWBA).

The NWBA is a community-wide group of over 175 partner organizations that seeks to help hard-working families receive their full Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) through the "Earn It! Keep It! Save It!" Campaign.

This tax season, over 4,000 families received free tax preparation help at various IRS Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) sites located throughout the city and \$7,069,044.00 in federal refunds were returned to the area economy.

The NWBA partnered with Dr. Anthony Rolle's HOD 2780 Public Finance class at Vanderbilt University's Peabody College to conduct an economic analysis of the EITC and its impact on the Nashville economy. To find out more about the report and the NWBA, please follow the links below.
